- 1. County Councillor Thomas has been in communication with Royal Mail regarding Whitehill Post Box and it is believed that a reply on when this will be replaced it imminent.

- 4. Redberth Issues only one reply to the four concerns sent to PCC. Street Lighting at Lammas Vale, Redberth. Clerk to contact resident with the County Council's reply. Other items to be chased up.
- 5. Whitehill phone box Cllr Blayney has begun clearing around the area of the phone kiosk. He was unable to undertake work on the Carew phone kiosk due to obstruction by a vehicle on yellow lines. If this continues PCSO to be informed.
- 6. Carew Newton Cemetery Councillors attended the Cemetery to cut back the overgrowth recently and noticed evidence of moles. Clerk to arrange for their removal.

PLANNING

Community Councillors noted that the following application has been conditionally approved by PCC - 21/1220/PA - Land to rear of walled Garden Milton Manor

The following application has been received from PCC:

21/1247/PA - Land at Sageston Fields, 9 detached residential properties.

Councillors had perused the application and accompanying plans and documentation. They had also been made aware of the concern of a resident close to the proposed site i.e. site of their email to Planning Support. Following discussion and deliberation, it was agreed by all present that the opinion of Carew Community Councillors is that this application be approved by PCC. There were no adverse comments.

CORRESPONDENCE

Request for donation from Pisgah Church towards the cost of upkeep of graveyard. County Cllr Thomas declared an interest and withdrew from discussion. It was proposed by Cllr Griffiths and seconded by Dr Allen that £300 be donated. All present agreed.

ENHANCING PEMBROKESHIRE GRANT - CAREW AND MILTON PLAY AREAS

County Councillor Thomas informed that she was in the process of going through the annual inspection reports sent by PCC on the Play Areas in Milton and Carew. To date the renewal of matting seems to be the most necessary in both areas. Also rust is evident and painting is long overdue. It was agreed after much discussion to meet on Wednesday 15th June at 7 pm in the Meetings Room of Carew Memorial hall to complete the forms for Enhancing Pembrokeshire Grant.

Also the Community Council were informed of successful local applications for play areas with grants from the Heritage Lottery Fund and this to be looked into also.

COUNTY COUNCILLORS REPORT;

County Councillor Thomas informed that she was involved in meeting with officers at PCC regarding Paskeston Lane and Milton Traffic concerns She is also looking at the speed limit in Whitehill through to Cresswell Quay. County Councillor Thomas is also looking into various other issues/concerns sent to her directly from residents in Carew Parish.

County Councillor Thomas was surprised to learn of the situation with regards to dual purpose bins in the Parish. The bin at the end of Bartletts Well Road on Carew Park Estate is no longer there. The bin at the covered bus shelter in Milton is also missing. Clerk to contact PCC urgently regarding these.

County Councillor Thomas informed that the funeral bier in the Old Mill in Carew is the property of Carew Community Council. Clerk to ascertain if this is covered by Pembrokeshire Coast National Park Authority/Castle Insurance as it is not on the Community Council insurance. Also Clerk to ensure it is listed on the Asset Register.
